

# UNDERSTANDING RESPONSIBLE AGRICULTURE INVESTMENTS (RAI)

**CFS-RAI** is a UN voluntary and non-binding framework applied in line with existing national and international law. It guides actions of all stakeholders engaged in agriculture and food systems by defining principles that promote the much-needed responsible investment, enhance livelihoods, and guard against and mitigate risks to food security and nutrition. CFS-RAI builds on the Voluntary Guidelines on the Responsible Governance on Tenure of Land, Fisheries and Forests in the Context of National Food Security (VGGT) and the Voluntary Guidelines on the Progressive Realization of the Right to Adequate Food in the Context of National Food Security.



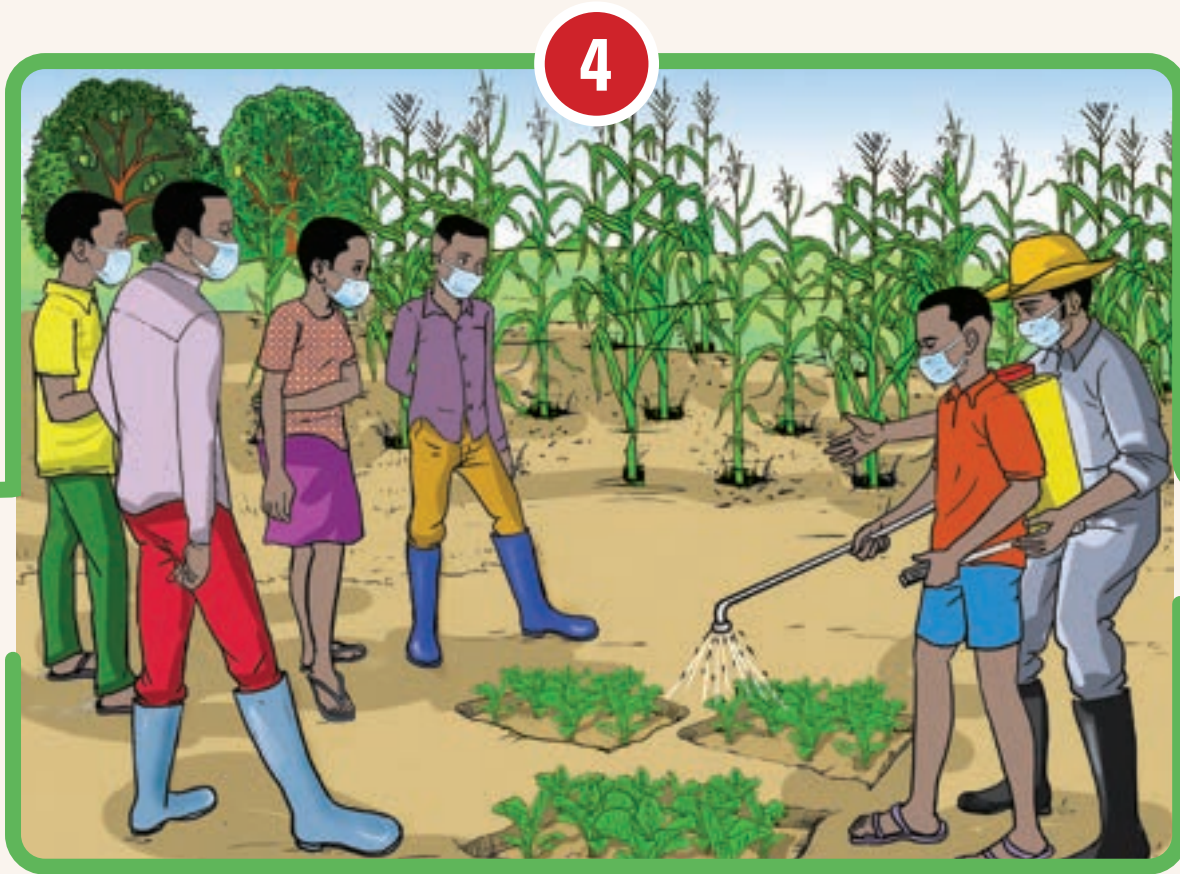

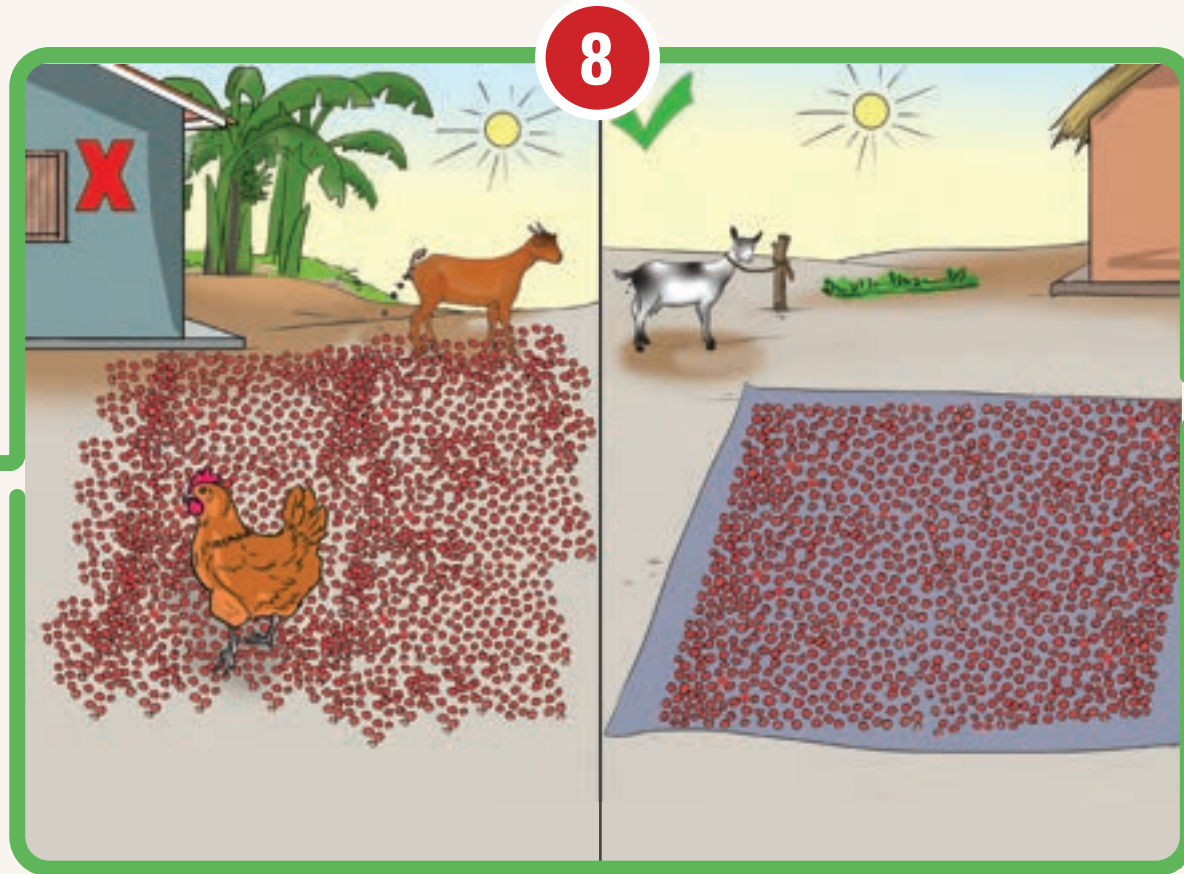

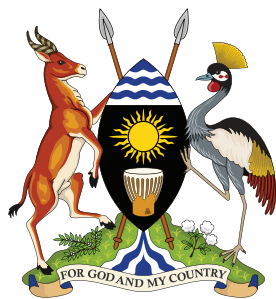
